

## EXPLANATION OF YOUR BILLS:

CUSTOMER CHARGE:	A basic semi-annual fee assessed to every customer regardless of the amount of water used, if any. Although some customers may use very little water, or none at all, it was decided that every customer should make equal, yet minimal, contribution to the maintenance and improvement of the water distribution system. The customer charge has appeared on all bills since 1994.
RATE:	Current charge for water use.
BILLING PERIOD:	Dates of previous and present readings.
INTEREST:	Finance charge at rate allowed by law.

## **REGULATIONS:**

1. OWNERS OF PROPERTY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT OF WATER BILLS.
2. OUTSIDE READING DEVICES ARE NOT ALWAYS ACCURATE. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR WATER REGISTERED ON THE ACTUAL HEAD OF THE METER.
3. METERS ARE THE PROPERTY OF THE WATER DISTRICT AND SHALL NOT BE REMOVED OR DISTURBED WITHOUT PERMISSION.
4. AGENTS OF THIS DISTRICT MAY ENTER ANY PREMISE SUPPLIED WATER BY THIS DISTRICT AT ALL REASONABLE HOURS TO INSPECT PIPES, METERS, CONNECTIONS AND OTHER WATER FIXTURES.
5. THE WATER DISTRICT MAY AT ANY TIME SHUT OFF WATER FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING NECESSARY REPAIRS TO THE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, FAILURE TO OBSERVE RULES AND REGULATIONS AND/OR FAILURE TO PAY WATER BILLS.
6. ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS AVAILABLE AT THE DISTRICT OFFICE ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY A VOTE OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS.
